## What inspired you to get into the finance industry?

I was fortunate enough to have a summer internship at Lehman Brothers in Equities Operations in 1999. I sat on the trading floor and was immediately hooked on the energetic, market-driven, client-focused environment. I had thought about being a journalist or lawyer but after that summer, knew I wanted to work in sales and trading.

#### What can companies do to increase the representation of women in finance?

Connect with women college students and educate them on careers in finance. I've spent 20+ years working in Fixed Income/Securitized Products but never even knew this path existed as a high school and early college student. Additionally, success begets success- early in my career I worked for several women Managing Directors that were excellent role models and helped me see that the longterm career path was achievable. Having diverse senior leadership will drive recruiting and retaining more women.

#### How can companies invest in their women employees to prepare them for leadership roles?

In my own experience, women are less likely then their male counterparts to raise their hands for "reach" positions and more likely to pass the opportunity to someone else because they are afraid to fail or think they are not ready. Through a few different experiences, I've seen that no one is every quite "ready" to step into a role, run with a large client opportunity, or create a new business opportunity. You learn "on the go," and through hard work, make it a success. Being ready for the next job is less about having the perfect resume and more about having the chance to tackle challenges. Good managers give you the opportunity to take on situations that require you to push yourself and provide feedback. The more you navigate, the more you realize you are capable of the next thing, even if you don't know exactly what that looks like upfront. I've been lucky to have leaders that have shown me what this kind of trust and enablement looks like.

# What policies and/or benefits can companies put in place to better support their women employees?

Flexibility goes a long way, especially when we have children.
